CONDUCTING AND PRESENTING YOUR PAEDIATRIC INFECTIOUS DISEASE RESEARCH

5 November 2019

GENERAL:

The World Society for Pediatric Infectious Diseases (WSPID) will be hosting a Research Workshop on 5 November 2019 from 08:00-16:00, prior to the start of the main WSPID Congress. The workshop will be conducted in English.

The workshop will consist of two components:

1. **Short practical lectures** by leading researchers on aspects of research, with a focus on paediatric infectious diseases.
2. **Oral presentations by 5 selected Research Workshop participants.** Five abstracts will be selected for the Research Workshop and the abstract presenter will be assigned two mentors who will assist the abstract presenter with developing their presentation prior to the Workshop. The abstract presenter will deliver a 10-minute oral presentation of their WSPID 2019 submitted abstract to the audience of Research Workshop participants and faculty. Research Workshop participants and faculty will offer constructive comments and suggestions following each presentation.

AIMS:

- To assist early career researchers with the design, conduct, and presentation of paediatric infectious disease research in resource-challenged and resource-advantaged settings.
- To facilitate interaction between early career and established researchers in an informal, collegial setting.
